Fr Aloysius Ambruzzi SJ I Term-1928-1932 II Term- 1935-1937

Fr A. Ambruzzi, the last of the non-Indian Rectors was appointed in May 1928 and held the office for nine years in all. He was an outstanding professor, eloquent orator and an able administrator and builder with a vision.

Fr Ambruzzi has a record of meritorious service. For nine years, he was Rector and with an interval of three years, Principal of St Aloysius College also.




Fr Thomas Gonsalves SJ I Term - 1932-1935 II Term - 1937-1939

Fr Thomas always had sympathy and encouragement for the students. In him, everyone found a broad-minded Principal. Under him, College entered upon a new chapter of service and success.





A visitor to the tower got the panoramic view of Mangalore's exquisite beauty. The tower was also the subject of the poem written by a student in 1935.






LET'S KNOW MORE ABOUT SACAA

SACAA AFTER 1930

The Golden Jubilee of St Aloysius College had left lasting results behind it, and the Aloysian Association was one of them. The Aloysian Supplement published three times in a year, was the organ of the Association.

The Association was revived on the occasion of Golden Jubilee in the hope that it would serve the double purpose of bringing Aloysians closer to Alma Mater and of uniting them more intimately among themselves.

At the annual general meeting of the Aloysians in Bombay, held on 29th May, 1898, it was unanimously resolved that an association be formed for the furtherance of the common interests of the pupils of St Aloysius College, Mangalore.

Crèche At St Aloysius Institutions, Mangaluru





The blessing and inauguration of the Aloysian Crèche was held on the 5th of January 2022. Dr Rose Veera Dsouza (Dean – Arts Faculty, St Aloysius College) inaugurated the Centre. Rev. Dr Leo Dsouza SJ (Director – Applied Biology Lab) blessed the Centre. Rev. Fr Melwin J Pinto SJ (Rector – St Aloysius Institutions), Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ (Principal – St Aloysius College) and staff members were present.

This facility is created for the children of all the staff under the Mangalore Jesuit Educational Society. Being centrally located in the campus at Kodialbail, Mangaluru, this day care center is easily accessible to the staff of Primary School, High School, St Aloysius Gonzaga School, PU College and the Degree College.

Children between the age of 6 months and 3 years will be taken care of by well experienced staff, including a qualified nurse.

Following were the recipients of the 'Eminent Aloysian Alumni Awards':

- Mr Mavila Vishwanathan Nair is the Non-Executive Chairman of the Trans Union CIBIL, India's largest credit bureau and also the Non-Executive Chairman of KFINTECH Pvt Ltd, a leading Registrar and Transfer Agent.
- Dr L.C. Soans is a renowned practitioner of organic farming in Moodubidri. He is also a recipient of Karnataka Rajyotsava Award -2016
- Mr Jeeth Milan Roche is an accomplished entrepreneur and renowned environmentalist. He is the founder of Mangalore Green Brigade and has been on a mission to make Mangalore a green city.
- Lt. General (Rtd) Ravi Eipe fought in the 1962 China war at battle of Namkachu as a 22 year old Captain. He took part in "Operation Pawan" in Sri Lanka for which he was awarded "Ati Vishist Seva Medal" in 1989 and was awarded "Param Vishist Seva Medal" in 1997.
- Prof. Edmund J B Frank has donned various managerial positions of some of the top notch business organizations. He lives the true vision and mission of the College, being a person for and with others involving in several philanthropic and charity ventures.
- **Dr Cletus J M D'Souza** is a renowned Professor of Biochemistry known for his erudition and superior research credentials. He has established himself as one of the most sought after mentor and research guide in the field of Biochemistry.



Students from Batch 1971 Create History, Return to the Alma mater for a Golden Reunion

The golden bells chimed at St Aloysius College on 10 January 2022 when at 9.00 in the morning members from Batch 1971 after breakfast at the Gelge Hall assembled before the Administrative block in the company of the Rector Fr Melwin Pinto SJ, Principal Rev Dr Praveen Martis SJ and Registrar Dr Alwyn D'sa.

After a ceremonial march past by the N.C.C. Army, Navy and Air Wing cadets the Aloysian flag was hoisted and the Organizing Committee Chairman Mr Walter D'Souza declared the Golden Reunion of batch 1971 open. Soon after thirty one Batch 1971 members marched in a procession escorted by a band and N.C.C. cadets, to LCRI Block. The Advanced Instrumentation Centre gifted by the Batch 1971 for research activity at a cost of Rs one crore and seventy five lakhs was inaugurated by the Rev. Fr Melwin Pinto SJ, Rector.











The Rector Rev. Fr Melwin Pinto SJ and the Principal Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ solemnly handed over to the students who graduated in the year 1971 a Commendation Certificate as symbolic of the Convocation Degree Certificate, a Memento and a Sash. This was a graduation ceremony that has no parallels meaning thereby this was the first of its kind organized in the whole world.

Thanks to Prof. Edmund Frank who conceived of the idea of the ceremonial march past and the Graduation ceremony which were the highlights of the celebration. Another important highlight was the presentation of a Cheque for Rs One Crore and Seventy one Lakhs by the office bearers of Batch 1971 on behalf of all the batch members. The third highlight in the programme was the release of the Batch 1971 Golden Souvenir by the Rector Rev. Fr Melwin Pinto and handing over the first copy to the Editor Prof. Edmund Frank.

The St Aloysius College Flag with Golden Batch 1971 name printed on it, which was hoisted at march past was folded and handed over to the Chairman of batch 1971, Mr Walter D'Souza. In the presence of SACAA President, Mr J. S. Stephen Pinto, the flag was handed over by Mr Walter D'Souza to Mr James Mendonca in the absence of Mr Archibald Menezes, Chairman of the Golden Batch 1972.
