Rev. Fr Charles Ghezzi SJ

1911-1913

Fr Ghezzi's role as the Principal was wonderful. During his tenure as a Principal, he was nominated to be an Ordinary Fellow of the University of Madras.

He had also been appointed as an Examiner of Latin to the University of Madras. Apart from being the Rector, Fr Aegidius Frachetti was also appointed as the Superior of the Mission of Mangalore.

Father Frachetti proved to be excellent with his sound judgement, rare tact and keen insight into character.

Fr Cornelius Perazzi SJ 1913-1921

Fr Perazzi belonged to that band of steady and silent workers who draw little attention to themselves, but without whose irreplaceable role an institution would starve and die.

In the course of Fr Perazzi's Rectorship, the college was visited three times by the Governor of Madras, twice by Lord Pentland and once by Lord Wellingdon.

Fr Leo Proserpio SJ 1921-1928

Fr Proserpio had a long range view and could foresee the great importance of science subjects as early as 1922. It was through his strenous efforts that today we have Physics and Chemistry laboratories for the B.Sc classes.

He was given the title of the ' third founder' of the college. When the Mangalore magazine was transformed into the College annual, Fr Proserpio was its first Editor.


Reminiscences from the Past

LET'S KNOW SACAA

In the history of the St Aloysius College Alumni Association (SACAA) there is very little to record from its founding in 1901 to its revival in 1930, except that in the first 28 years of its existence about 300 members were enrolled.

The first Aloysian Alumni Association was started in Bombay. Although at the beginning, there was no official association as such.

At the annual general meeting of the Aloysians in Bombay, held on 29th May, 1898, it was unanimously resolved that an association be formed for the furtherance of the common interests of the pupils of St Aloysius College, Mangalore.

SACAA launches 'Miyawaki-Urban Forest' Campaign

St Aloysius College, Autonomous officially launched the 'Miyawaki- Urban Forest' campaign on 24 July, 2021. This initiative was organised by the St Aloysius College Alumni Association (SACAA).

The objective is to use the Miyawaki method of plantation, a technique developed by Japanese botanist Akira Miyawaki that allows for the rapid growth of dense, natural forests.

P Shridhar, Range Forest Officer, launched the campaign and spoke about the Miyawaki Plantation process as well as numerous environmental factors. He emphasised the necessity of growing native plant species and also discussed how infrastructure has taken precedence over the environment in recent years.
